VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

To study at Spectrum Film School, international students must obtain a Student Pass, which is Kenya's equivalent of a student visa. Below is a detailed guide to assist you in successfully applying for and obtaining your Student Pass:

Step 1: Apply to Spectrum Film School

- Complete the application process and ensure you meet the requirements for your chosen course.
- Once admitted, you will receive:
 - Admission Letter: Confirms your acceptance into the program.
 - Support Letter: A document addressed to the Director of Immigration Services, detailing your course name and duration.

These documents are essential for your visa application.

Step 2: Register for an eCitizen Account

- Visit the Kenya Immigration eCitizen Portal and create an account.
- Log in to access the Student Pass Application Form (Form 30).

Step 3: Complete the Online Application

- 1. Fill out the form accurately. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
- 2. Gather the following required documents:
- Signed commitment letter from your sponsor (if applicable).
- Copy of sponsor's national passport and proof of funds for self-sponsored students.
- Passport bio-data page and two recent passport-sized color photos.
- Academic certificates (certified) if joining tertiary institutions for the first time.
- Proof of current immigration status if you are already in Kenya.
- For minors, include:
 - A consent letter from parents.
 - Copy of parent's passport and birth certificate as proof of relationship.
- Documents in foreign languages must be translated into English by a recognized institution or notary.

Step 4: Verification by Spectrum Film School

- Print Form 30 and send it to admissions@spectrumfilmschool.com for verification.
- Our Head of Academics or Principal will sign and stamp the form to authenticate it for submission to immigration.

Step 5: Submit the Application

- Take your completed application and supporting documents to the Immigration Offices at Nyayo House, Nairobi, Alien Section, Counter No. 9.
- Alternatively, upload the documents online through your eCitizen portal.

Step 6: Pay the Application Fee

- The cost for a student pass is approximately USD 100 (KSH 10,000) per year.
- Payment options:
- 1.M-Pesa: Pay-Bill No. 206206.
- 2. Bank cheque payable to PS Ministry of Interior and Coordination of National Government.

Step 7: Processing

- Processing may take up to 2 months, so apply well in advance.
- You will receive an email notification regarding the status of your application.

Step 8: Collect Your Student Pass

- Once approved, collect your pass from the Department of Immigration Offices, Ground Floor, Room 16, Nyayo House.
- On the same day, register as an alien in Kenya.

Important Notes

Renewals

- If your course extends beyond the initial visa duration, apply for a renewal through the same process.
- Submit academic progress reports and a copy of your current Student Pass.

Legal Obligations

 Spectrum Film School is required to inform immigration if a student discontinues their studies due to poor performance, indiscipline, or other reasons.





